<b>RULE 20-2c WHEN TO REDROP (7)</b>	
(i)	Rolls Into and Comes to Rest in Hazard
(ii)	Rolls Out of and Comes to Rest Outside Hazard
(iii)	Rolls Onto and Comes to Rest on Putting Green
(iv)	Rolls and Comes to Rest Out of Bounds
(v)	Rolls to and Comes to Rest in Position Where There is Interference by Condition from Which Relief was Taken under Rule 24-2b (Immovable Obstruction), Rule 25-1 (Abnormal Ground Conditions), Rule 25-3 (Wrong Putting Green) or Local Rule (Rule 33-8a), or Rolls Back into Pitch-Mark from Which it was Lifted Under Rule 25-2 (Embedded Ball)
(vi)	Rolls and Comes to Rest More Than Two Club-Lengths From where it First Struck Part of the Course
(vii)	Rolls and Comes to Rest Nearer Hole Than: (a) Original Position or Estimated Position (Rule 20-2b) unless otherwise Permitted by Rules; or (b) Nearest Point of Relief or Maximum Available Relief (Rule 24-2, 25-1 or 25-3); or (c) Point Where Original Ball Last Crossed Margin of Water Hazard or Lateral Water Hazard (Rule 26-1)

<b>ACTS THAT CADDIE MAY PERFORM (7)</b>	
12-1	Search for Player's Ball as Provided in Rule 12-1
13-4	Place Player's Club's in Hazard – Exception 1 under Rule 13-4
16-1c	Repair Old Hole Plugs and Ball Marks on Putting Green
23-1	Remove Loose Impediments on Line of Putt and Elsewhere
20-1	Mark Position of Ball without Lifting It
21	Clean Player's Ball
24-1	Remove Movable Obstruction

<b>RULE 6-8a DISCONTINUANCE OF PLAY – WHEN PERMITTED (4)</b>	
(i)	Committee Has Suspended Play
(ii)	Player Believes There is Danger From Lightning
(iii)	Player Seeks Decision from Committee on Doubtful or Disputed Point (Rules 2-5 and 34-3)
(iv)	Some Other Good Reason Such As Sudden Illness

<b>PRINCIPLE</b>	
Always cost penalty stroke to drop ball out of Hazard
